## keynote- Professor Kevin Cokley, Ph.D.

K evin Cokley, Ph.D. is the University Diversity and Social Transformation Professor and Professor of Psychology at the University of M ichigan where he serves as A ssociate Chair of Diversity Initiatives for the Department of Psychology. Previously he was Chair of the Department of Educational Psychology at the University of Texas, where he held the Oscar and A nne M auzy Regents Professorship for Educational Research and Development. He has been a Fellow of the University of Texas System and University of Texas A cademy of Distinguished Teachers, past Director of the Institute for Urban Policy Research \& A nalysis, and Professor of A frican and A frican Diaspora Studies.

His research and teaching can be broadly categorized in the area of A frican A merican psychology, with a focus on racial identity and understanding the psychological and environmental factors that impact A frican A merican students' academic achievement. Dr. Cokley studies the psychosocial experiences of A frican A merican students and students of color and is currently exploring the impostor phenomenon and its relationship to mental health and academic outcomes.

He is the past Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Black Psychology, holds the title of Distinguished Psychologist and received the Scholarship A ward from the A ssociation of Black Psychologists. He is President of the Society for the Psychological Study of Culture, Ethnicity, and Race, and was elected to Fellow status in the A merican Psychological A ssociation for his contributions to ethnic minority psychology and counseling psychology. He is the recipient of the Regents' Outstanding Teaching A ward, the Charles and Shirley Thomas A ward for mentoring ethnic minority students, and the 10 Rising Stars of the A cademy award by Diverse Issues in Higher Education.

He is author of the 2014 book "The M yth of Black Anti-Intellectualism" that challenges the notion that A frican A merican students are anti-intellectual, and editor of the 2021 book "M aking Black Lives M atter: Confronting Anti-Black Racism." He has written several Op-Eds in major media outlets on topics such as critical race theory, Blacks' rational mistrust of police, the aftermath of Ferguson, police and race relations, racism and W hite supremacy, the importance of ethnic studies, and racial disparities in school discipline. His research has been recognized in media outlets including the New York Times, U SA Today, and Inside Higher Education.
